A Tandem jump is a one on one skydive where you are "attached", with a special harness to an instructor, and therefore is the quickest way to experience freefall. You will both exit the aircraft and freefall for about 40 seconds at a speed of 120 mph at which time the instructor will pull the ripcord to deploy a parachute that is specifically designed for two people. You will then assist the instructor in guiding the parachute to an on target landing at the drop zone.

Tandem jumping is the easiest way to enjoy this experience of a lifetime. The training for a tandem jump takes approximately 5 minutes and is taught at the drop zone.

To do a Tandem Skydive you must get parental permission if you are younger than 18.

You must not weigh more than **100 kgs**. If you exceed our recommended weight limit, call for additional information.

Important Information!!!!

1. Accommodation such as camping is free, the log cabins are R 50.00 per person and there are Bed & Breakfasts in town all of which can be booked through us.
2. The showers are **HOT** and always well maintained!!!
3. Clothing is really important!!!! Please **DO NOT** wear any boots like Hi – Tec which have hooks on them, you will not be allowed to jump in these. Lace up tekkies (NB: lace-up running shoes) is always the best.
4. Bring something warm for winter like track suit pants or jeans. A long sleeve top **WITH OUT** a hood is required. You may **NOT** jump with rings on as these once again pose a safety risk of getting caught in the door. A jump suit will be provided for you at the drop zone to protect your clothes.
5. The canteen offers from a Full English breakfast to snacks, hamburgers, hot dogs and a home cooked meal on Saturday evenings. For those wanting to go out there are a few restaurants in Carletonville, you can just ask at the drop zone.
6. Our Bush pub is where we all sit and have a few drinks to relax after a good day of jumping. The bar is well stocked and offers a wide range of Beers, Spirits and shooters. They also often arrange Promo Evenings in conjunction with big events which we normally advertise on our web site.

Directions to the Drop Zone

- ✚ From the Beyers Naude bridge on the N1 highway (Western Bypass) head south on the N1, towards Bloemfontein
- ✚ 20km from Beyers Naude, follow the N12 to Kimberley and Potchefstroom
- ✚ pass over one set of traffic lights
- ✚ pass over a large 4-way stop intersection (the cross road is the R28)
- ✚ 60km from Beyers Naude, just after the Libanon Mine turn off, take the Carletonville turn-off (R501) to the right (turn off the N12)
- ✚ Continue for approximately 20km to the 4-way stop intersection. There is a fountain on the left, and the Carletonville Town emblem on the opposite right corner.
- ✚ Proceed straight over this intersection
- ✚ About 1km further on, proceed straight over another 4-way stop intersection (the cross road is the R500)
- ✚ Take the next turn to the right, into Dolomite Street
- ✚ Take the first left, after about 300m, into Coronation Street
- ✚ After about 2,3km, there will be another 4-way stop intersection. Proceed straight over this intersection.
- ✚ Follow the left fork as the road splits, into Grundling Street
- ✚ Proceed for about 1km to the stop street.
- ✚ There will be an open field in front of you.
- ✚ Turn left into Rautenbach Street
- ✚ As this street turns 90 degrees to the left, take the dirt road to the right. There is a big sign!
- ✚ After about 1,2km on the dirt road, you will see the hangars and the club's buildings off to the left.

You will now see people having loads and loads of fun. You are at Johannesburg Skydiving Club. **Welcome!!!**
